SUMMARY OF DUTIES

Reports to the Aquatic Supervisor. Monitors wading pool and performs wading pool maintenance duties in accordance with City Policy and Procedure Manual, Occupational Health and Safety Act and WHMIS Regulation.

GENERAL DUTIES

Performs pool maintenance including draining and filling the pool, cleaning the pool area of debris and maintaining chemicals at the desirable level.

Ensures that the lifesaving equipment is maintained and available.

Enforces wading pool rules and responds to customer inquiries in a professional manner.

Performs rescues and first aid within accordance of certification standards.

Reports known or potential hazards, maintenance concerns, and unsafe conditions immediately to the Aquatic Supervisor or designate.

Completes appropriate documentation as required including pool log, attendance, accident and incident reports.

Works in accordance with the provisions of applicable health and safety legislation and all City of Hamilton corporate and departmental policies and procedures related to occupational health and safety.

Performs other duties as assigned, which are directly related to the responsibilities of the job.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Lifesaving Society Wading Pool Attendant Certification or Bronze Medallion.
- 2. Standard First Aid Certificate with CPR-C
- 3. Knowledge of rules and regulations governing conduct of the public at wading pools.
- 4. Good communication and interpersonal skills.
