CASUAL SERVICE LINE WORKER (COMPRESSOR)

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

Under direct supervision of the Foreman/Woman on duty, fuel, clean and prepare buses and other vehicles for charter, route and general service. Operate Compressor Station and maintain all records as required by HSR and governing Acts.

GENERAL DUTIES:

Operate all company vehicles.

Sweep, mop, vacuum, fuel, oil, wash and park all vehicles.

Inspect to ensure all vehicle lighting, signal and warning systems are working.

Check each vehicle for items such as damaged seats, torn upholstery, cracked glass, tire damage or low pressure and graffiti.

Clean service line bays and pits.

Probe and dump fareboxes.

Probe A.P.C. equipped vehicles.

Operate forklift, pusher vehicle and other equipment/vehicles as required.

Steam clean vehicles or components as required.

Remove/install signs in or on vehicles as required.

Assist tradesmen and others, as assigned.

Service and charter check outside vehicles as required.

Perform NGV compressor station checks, maintain station log books, follow operating instructions.

Responsible to comply with the policies of the Company with respect to rules, regulations and safe working practices adopted by the Engineering/Maintenance Division.

Note: The duties and relationships outlined in this description are intended to cover only the significant responsibilities. Other duties which are related to the Engineering/Maintenance Division functions may be assigned from time to time by the Supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have and maintain a valid Ontario Compressor Operator's License or Fourth Class Stationary Engineer's License.
- 2. Must be able to obtain and maintain a valid Ontario Driver's License, Class "D" with a "Z" endorsement.
- 3. Must be able to work evening/night shifts.

- 4. Be able to work in adverse weather conditions.
- 5. Be able to operate buses with standard or automatic transmissions.
